MONTHLY FACT SHEET AS AT 30 NOVEMBER 2025

Portfolio Objectives: To maximise risk adjusted returns through a diversified portfolio across global equities, bonds, commodities and alternative strategies.

Strategy: We adjust asset class exposure tactically and strategically to align with market cycles.

Performance: The Somerston Multi Asset Fund (US1 class) fell by -1.3% in the month and rose by +1.9% over the last three months. Our composite reference index rose by +0.3% in the month and rose by +5.0% over the last three months.
